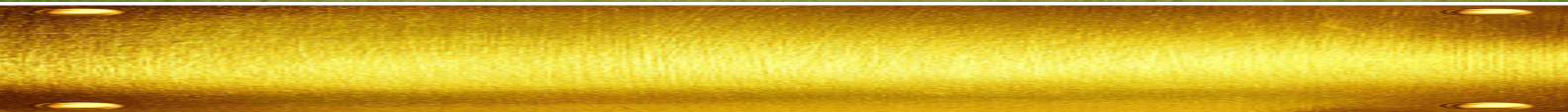

**My dear sisters,**

We have twin feasts on August 15th - the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Independence Day of our Mother land, India. *And with freedom from fear comes the obligation to ACT.*

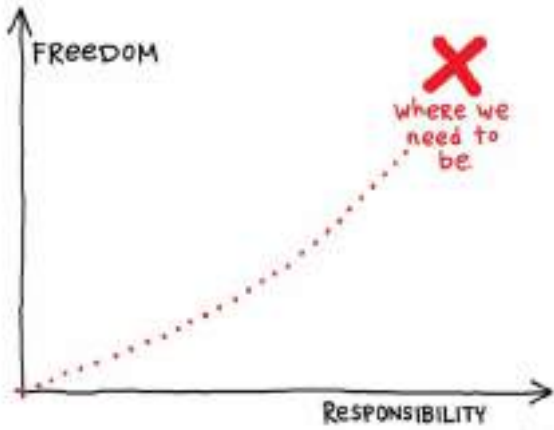
These are inseparable twins, like flesh and nails. One cannot exist without the other. To be truly free, one has to be responsible. And to be truly responsible, one has to be free.

This is now a very challenging task since many people today have all sorts of ideas about what freedom is. And regarding responsibility, hardly any attention is given to it, especially among the young.

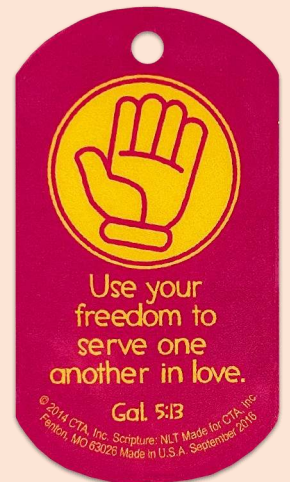
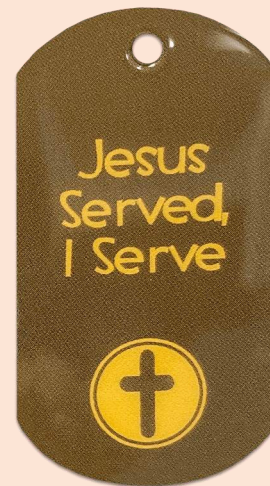
Responsibility means being held accountable for our actions. It might involve figuring out how to get paid for our work, owning our mistakes, or having others count on us.

We use many habit programs in our minds, as we use many software programs in a computer which work in the background to do our jobs. It is not relevant that who has created the program. The two most important aspect of both type of these programs are.

## **WHAT IS THAT PROGRAM DOING?**

Is it relevant & economic to be used in our current circumstances? Habits and software programs both work on logical principles. In both the cases the work is done at the backend. The user deals with its frontend counterpart which is hardware devices or mind in the human body. Many times, the user is unaware of the presence or existence of these programs.

Ever since we take birth, we are constantly programmed for habits by the prevailing social or domestic way of working in the area of our interest. We may even inherit some of the habit programs due to our unique position in the society/family. As we grow up and come out of protection provided to us, we also learn new ways of doing things in the area of our influence.

The new learnt habit programs are initiated while old programs which are not relevant or economic are switched off. This acquisition of knowledge is a continuous process in the life of a person. As we keep adding new software programs in the memory of the computer system, in a similar way we keep adding habit programs to our unconscious mind.

## **BIASES IN LIFE**

As we start living in the society, biases creep in, due to divisions based on many considerations. Firstly we have to have a nationality. It is not our choice most of the time and imposed upon us mostly at the time of birth. Later you can change it not an easy decision but at any one point of your life you belong to a nation and thus bound by its law & policies.
